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
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
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

Disposed means the status of the application must be Approved, Rejected, Allotted or Disbursed. Please note, you cannot apply the application for A.Y. 20-21 if your application is in under scrutiny or send back status.



Example 1:- If your current course was first year pursing for A.Y 2018-19 then for A.Y 2019-20 follow the below steps


- Click on delete button to delete the entirely filled pursuing course information and again fill all details of last year pursuing course and select as completed and then fill current year pursuing course details accordingly
